## WHAT'S NEW IN THE INDUSTRY?

More investors have shown keen interest in managing and distributing Yangon's water ever since the Yangon City Development Committee (YCDC) has announced its privatisation of the city's water in August 2019.

The ambitious New Yangon City project has reached a framework agreement in April 2018 for US\$1.5 billion for Stage 1 infrastructural work, including two bridges, roads, power plants, water and wastewater treatment plants and an industrial estate.

The Kinmoonchyon and Shwenettaung Dams in the Athayan River will be able to supply 6.5 million gallons of drinking water daily to the 14 wards in Mawlamyine by 2022, according to Mon State Development Committee.

In 2019, Myanmar has approved a loan worth EUR29.96 million from the Netherlands FMO and ING Bank to build a water treatment plant with the capacity of 7 million gallons per day (MGD) in Pyigyidagun Township, Mandalay Region.

IGE Energy Co Ltd has introduced a new substance in effective biological wastewater treatment – PVA gel, or polyvinyl alcohol hydrogel. Lasting for at least a decade, the gel is said to be able to cut time and costs in casting off waste.
